


## NOTICE INVITING BIDS FOR CITY WELL 6 PROJECT

The City of San Juan Bautista ("City") will accept sealed bids for the "City Well 6 Project ("Project"), by or before **Tuesday, July 10, 2018, at 2:00 P.M.** at the Front Counter at City Hall at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

1. **Location and Description.** The Project is located at 987 San Juan Hollister Road, San Juan Bautista, California, and the scope of work is generally described as follows:
  - a. Mechanical and piping to convert an existing agricultural well to a municipal water well. All existing piping will be removed and replace with 6-inch ductile iron spools that include an air vent, backflow assembly, cla-valve with blow-off to near-by sewer
  - b. Replace sounding tube
  - c. Place concrete footing around wellhead (minimum 3 feet around wellhead)
  - d. Provide and install 6-inch ductile iron pipe to water main in nearby public street
  - e. Provide and install 10-inch PVC pipe to sewer manhole in in nearby public street
  - f. Provide and install chlorine dosing system
  - g. Fence the site with 8-foot cyclone fence that includes a 12-foot sliding gate
  
2. **License, DIR Registration and Prevailing Wage Requirements**
  - a. **License** - At the time of award of contract, the successful bidder shall possess a Class "A" contractor's license or a combination of Specialty Class "C" licenses sufficient to cover all work to be performed.
  - b. **DIR Registration** - City may not accept a Bid Proposal from or enter into the Contract with a bidder, without proof that the bidder is registered with the California Department of Industrial Relations ("DIR") to perform public work under Labor Code section 1725.5, subject to limited legal exceptions.
  - c. **Prevailing Wage** - This Project is subject to the prevailing wage requirements applicable to the locality in which the Work is to be performed for each craft, classification or type of worker needed to perform the Work, including employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation, apprenticeship and similar purposes. Prevailing rates are available online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR> Each Contractor and Subcontractor must pay no less than the specified rates to all workers employed to work on the Project. The schedule of per diem wages is based upon a working day of eight hours. Holiday and overtime work must be at least time and one-half.

3. **Contract Documents.** Bid Documents can be obtained from San Juan Bautista's City's Clerk's office at (831)623-4661. As distribution of the bid document is by email, outside plan rooms and other means, it is the bidder's responsibility to advise the city staff that you need to be included on the official bid holders list for the project in order to receive any addenda.
  
4. **Bid Security.** The Bid Proposal must be accompanied by bid security of ten percent of the maximum bid amount, in the form of a cashier's or certified check made payable to City, or a bid bond executed by a surety licensed to do business in the State of California on the Bid Bond form included with the Contract Documents. The bid security must guarantee that within ten days after City issues the Notice of Award, the successful bidder will execute the Contract and submit the payment and performance bonds, insurance certificates and endorsements, and any other submittals required by the Contract Documents and as specified in the Notice of Award.
  
5. **Instructions to Bidders.** All bidders should carefully review the Instructions to Bidders before submitting a Bid Proposal.
